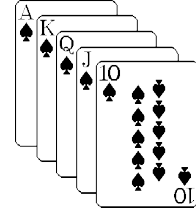

This state park is a wonderful treasure with trails meandering along rolling terrain, over bridges, and through woods. Front shoes or hoof boots recommended.

No alcohol on the trails. Use of any alcoholic beverages is prohibited in state parks.

Current Negative Coggins required at entrance. Limited primitive camping is available at the parking area starting Friday, September 17th. Water, fire rings, and a port-o-john will be available on site. Please clean up after you and your horse. All dogs must be on a leash. Provided lunch will follow after Poker Run Sunday. You are on your own for all other meals. Don't forget your chair(s).
