Directions

*Trails are located at 37093 Warrigue Rd Ivor VA 23866
Exit 460 W towards Petersburg off Rt 58 in Suffolk. In approximately 19 miles in Ivor, turn Right on Proctors Bridge Rd (just past stoplight in Ivor). Go about 2 miles, turn sharp Right on Warrigue Rd. Entrance is 0.7 miles on the Left (watch for sign). Follow driveway around about 1/2 mile or so to parking area in field by honor box.*
